

Haumaru Tāngata (Māori Health & Safety Framework) was presented at the inaugural Māori Health & Safety Conference in April 2023. The framework provides health and safety support for Māori employed in high-risk industries. Since the initial launch there has been significant interest in this framework from various organisations.





We are embarking on an exciting initiative to introduce a programme designed to implement Haumaru Tangata within 30 high-risk organisations. The core focus is to mentor organisations in high-risk industries, enhancing both their workplace safety and cultural responsiveness.

We invite your organisation to be among the first in the country to participate in this programme.

To aid organisations to embed the framework, we have developed Ko Au Te Ao, a self-assessment tool, based on the Rau (Foundation Principles) of Haumaru Tangata. Its purpose is to assist organisations to identify areas for improvement within their current health and safety policies and practices.

The programme is designed to be completed within eight weeks, and we will provide trained mentors to assist and support throughout the duration.

We will be testing Ko Au Te Ao in 5 organisations.

From April 2024

Our training resources will be designed and developed based on the framework.

Mentors from TRMA will be trained to assist organisations in implementing Haumaru Tangata.

We will assist in implementing Ko Au Te
Ao into 30 organisations with options for
training programs. After 3 months this
data will be captured and we will
evaluate and assess the data and insights
and share the findings and
recommendations with our participant
organisations.
